Educational Services





Madressah

(4 years to 18 years)

The most significant of services delivered at Zakaria is the evening madressah which was established in 1979, Alhamdulillah over 325 students attend to learn the fundamental elements of Islam and beyond. The flame of Iman is first kindled in the madrasah. The light of Iman first permeates the heart of a Muslim child in this environment. It teaches our young children moral values.

Our madressah caters for children from the tender age of 4 all the way up to 18. New Advanced Islamic classes have been successfully established in 2019 for 12-15 year olds and 16-18 year olds. The Advanced Islamic courses aims to develop from the early Madressah days and create within the students a stronger connection with Allah's revelation and the Sunnah of our Beloved Prophet Muhammad (sallallahu alayhi wasalam).

Special Educational Needs & Disabilities Madrasah

The Aim

The aim of the SEND madrasah is to provide an Islamic education to those children who have otherwise been unable to access mainstream madrasah education. The provision has been in operation since the 10th of December and the feedback has been overwhelmingly positive.

The Set-Up

The SEND madrasah is open to students aged 4-12 and currently runs for two sessions per week: Tuesday and Wednesday 5.15pm to 6.15pm. We currently have 12 students on record, 6 per session. The SEND madrasah is operationally run by the manager who has undertaken all the responsibilities involved in setting up a provision and delivering a quality curriculum.

The Cohort

The cohort is reflective of the make-up of the SEND needs in our local community. 9 of the 12 students have ASD with the other 3 students displaying co-morbidity with other conditions. This in itself demonstrates challenges, and henceforth the manager has delivered training on ASD to staff prior to employment. All ASD children are unique, thus the manager has used the EHCP documents which SEND children have to develop techniques which the key worker will use. This is all part of offering a highly individualised curriculum.

The Curriculum

The curriculum encompasses both Qur'an Studies and Islamic Studies. Every single session will have time dedicated to both. Qur'an Studies is taught using the traditional materials but supplemented by creative resources which may best enable the child to learn. The session also covers Islamic Studies. A comprehensive curriculum has been designed by the manager which covers Fiqh, Ahadith, Aqaid, Akhlaq, and Adaab. These areas are delivered in the form of topics such as 'Who is Allah and What is Islam' and 'Characteristics of a Muslim'. The curriculum is designed essentially to help the SEND student form an Islamic identity. The curriculum also specifies the kalimas and duas the students need to learn.

Our Vision & Ethos


To provide a well-rounded education allowing our girls to grow intellectually, become confident about their faith and values and develop into confident, responsible and inspiring young women.

Ladies Islamic Classes

A number of Islamic classes are delivered for our mothers and sisters. From beginner tajweed classes to Quran tafseer to Hadith lessons. Alhamdulillah the take up has been excellent; class sizes vary from 6 to 25. Tajweed classes are delivered in Urdu, Gujarati and English. The Education Centre is active with ladies classes running during the week in the mornings and afternoons. A typical Monday would entail a Quran tafseer class in English, 2 tajweed classes one in Urdu/Guarati and the other in English and a Quran tafseer class in Urdu – around 50 ladies in total attending on the day.

The feedback has been excellent, many learners are grateful for the opportunity to progress in their learning and to be able to do the same with qualified aalimah in a safe and comfortable setting. These classes also go a long way in aiding the mental wellbeing for many of the students.

We hope to provide the best possible Islamic Education and give students the necessary education to better themselves, and to become sources of guidance for others in the future.

Courses & Workshops

We have delivered a number of short courses and one-day workshops over the last 12 months. These workshops have brought great benefit to many many people not only locally but from further a field also – we have had attendees from Newcastle, Hull, Bradford, Leeds, Halifax and beyond - feedback has been outstanding.

Many of our course instructors have been well-recognised scholars and the topics have been varied, we hope to continue this in the forthcoming months inshaAllah.

Our course numbers have varied from 50 to nearly 200. Some of the courses delivered include Islamic manners, Islam and atheism, male hygiene, the art of successful parenting, and healthy muslim marriage.

Mental Wellbeing

Our aim is to support individuals and families to live healthy and harmonious lives. Our intention is to address some of the difficult and most pressing issues facing our community.

Approximately 1 in 4 people in the UK will experience a mental health problem each year. In England, 1 in 6 people report experiencing a common mental health problem (such as anxiety and depression) in any given week.

We have 12 trained Mental Health Champions who can support, provide direction and sign post those in need.

Addiction is a rapidly increasing problem within our community. Addiction to drugs, alcohol and gambling are taking a grip of people's lives and having extremely harmful consequences. We have held substance misuse and addiction workshops for men, women and children and intend to continue to take this on and be a support for those in need.
